AN APPEAL TO THE MEMBERS OF NCBE AND AIBOC

ALL INDIA NATION WIDE STRIKE ON 2ND SEPTEMBER, 2015
NCBE AND AIBOC PLEDGE FRATERNAL SUPPORT

Comrades,

A national convention of workers was held under the banner of joint platform of all the Central Trade Unions of the Country along with Independent National Federations of all sectors and service establishments on 26.05.2015. The convention decided to hold all India General Strike on 2nd September, 2015 on its 12 points Charter of Demand.

Further, Seven trade unions of employees and officers in the Banking Sector namely AIBEA, AIBOA, BEFI, INBOC, INBEF, NOBW and NOBO have given a call for a one-day All India Strike in all Banks (both in Private and Public Sector) on Wednesday, 2nd September, 2015 protesting against (1) the anti-worker, anti people and pro-corporate policies of the Central Govt., (2) the proposed adverse amendments to the Labour Laws, (3) retrograde anking Reforms, attacks on trade union rights and demands of bank employees and bank officers and (4) supporting the charter of demands declared by the National Trade Union Convention. All India Reserve Bank Employees' Association and All India Reserve Bank Workers' Federation have also resolved to observe Strike on the same day protesting against the anti-worker, anti-people and pro-corporate actions of the Central Govt. and the amendment of Labour Laws etc.

AIBOC and NCBE, the two leading trade unions in banking sector, too have risen to the occasion and decided to extend fraternal support to the call for strike on the 2nd September, 2015.

In this backdrop, we urge upon all our members to render whole-hearted fraternal support to the striking work-force of the Country and the Central Trade Unions and join them in opposing the Government's anti-labour and anti-people policies' with equal vehemence.
