722 members and guests from every possible nook and corner of the module, attended the 37<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of SBIOA (Bengal Circle) of Administrative Zonal Committee, Burdwan braving the inclement weather.

Inauguration of the programme by hoisting of the Association's flag and by paying homage to the martyrs was done by Com Shubhajyoti Chattopadhyay, E.C. Member AISBOF and Deputy General Secretary SBIOA (Bengal Circle), Com Raktima Soren, Vice President, SBIOA (Bengal Circle), SBIOA Seniors and others. #### **BUSINESS SESSION**

Business Session of the meeting was started by the Zonal President, Com Pradip Mukhopadhyay. He welcomed on stage Com Kalyan Kumar Dey, Deputy General Secretary AlSBOF, Senior Vice-President AlBOC (WBSU) and President SBIOA (Bengal Circle) and Com Soumya Datta, Joint General Secretary AlBOC, Vice-President AlSBOF, President AlBOC (WBSU) and General Secretary SBIOA (Bengal Circle) on the stage. At the outset, he read out the Notice of the Meeting and the Agenda items. Thereafter, he took up the first agenda and requested Chief Regional Secretary, Com Biplab Sarkar to place his Secretarial Report for 2017 followed by AZC Treasurer, Com Prabir Bhowmik, to table the Statement of Accounts for the period in order to discuss and necessary adoption.

In his reply Com Biplab Sarkar briefly stated that as most issues raised was pertaining to the Circle and Federation, the same would be addressed by the General Secretary. However, he cautioned all members to be vigilant as they would be responsible for all sorts of transactions originated by them. So they should practice ethical banking and steer clear of all unethical practices.

Thereafter, at the behest of the Zonal President, the house unanimously passed and adopted the Chief Regional Secretary's Report and Statement of Accounts for the year 2017. Com Circle President, Kalyan Kumar Dey introduced the office bearers, elected unopposed, for the term 2018-20 as members of AZC Burdwan.

Then Com Soumya Datta, General Secretary addressed the house. He opened by speaking on the Great November Revolution. He outlined the current political and social situation of the country. He invited all to the seminar on FRDI Bill. He spoke on the online petition and the battle on social media taken up by the Association. He addressed all issues raised by the members like CDS. He spoke on the Vacation Policy, 100% medical reimbursement, work-life balance. He said that it was necessary to make sustained efforts to bring change. He spoke that special steps were to be taken up for women so that they could balance between work and family life. He said that efforts were being made to convert RMROs to generalist cadre. He mentioned about the roadmap for coming struggles and mentioned that it would only be possible through sustained efforts.

Com Kalyan Kumar Dey, President in his deliberation called for unity among members. This was his last meeting in the module as he was due for retirement on 31/01/2018. He requested all members to participate whole heartedly in Association activities. He was given a standing ovation by the house.
