CURTAIN RAISER – ALL ROADS LEAD TO CHENNAI  
A HISTORICAL MOMENT TO UNFOLD ON 23<sup>RD</sup>, 24<sup>TH</sup> AND 25<sup>TH</sup> OF  
JUNE 2018 – A MOMENT TO RECKON FOR ALL OF US**

Comrades, it is an inspiring moment for all of us. We are marching towards the 27<sup>th</sup> General Council of our beloved Federation scheduled at Chennai on 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> June 2018. It would be a historic moment for the rank and file across the country. Yes a grand gala event recapitulating the performance and progress achieved by our Federation and the journey of the last three years in ensuring protection and the welfare of over 1,00,000 officers working in branches and administrative offices in different parts of the country. Its' contribution to the growth of the economy is unparalleled.

The Federation has fully backed the Management of the Bank in achieving all its corporate goals including the successful completion and implementation of various government schemes meant for the uplifting of the common man. The Bank has spread its branches to the nook and corner of all parts of the country including the most difficult terrain where even the basic amenities are not available and the offices of the post office nor the railway lines have reached such difficult places. To day the revolutionary changes that were brought about, mainly the digital Banking technological advancement, computerization, the single window system, the large network of ATM;s, the diversification and expansion of the branches all over the globe enabling the bank to come within 50h rank amongst the global banks were all possible due to the active support and co-operation of the Federation.

5. The Conference is being attended by the Chairman and other senior executives of the Bank. The Chairman has been requested to inaugurate the Conference and address our members. The other senior executives both from the Corporate Center and from the circles are expected to participate in the conference.
