GENERAL MEETING SBIOA(BENGAL CIRCLE) HELD ON 25. 05. 2019 AT KOLKATA UNIVERSITY INSTITUTE AUDITORIUM

A General Meeting of SBIOA (Bengal Circle) was held with an enormous gathering of about 1012 members, esteemed leaders and former leaders of Federation, SBIOA seniors, comrades of different affiliates and the spouses of the Federation leaders. The stage of the meeting was well decorated and every endeavor was made to present the meeting with a commendable dimension.

At the outset, heart touching songs were performed by Com Baisali Mitra (Mallick), a member of "Srijan", the cultural wing of SBIOA (Bengal Circle).

The meeting was anchored by Com Indranil Pyne, Chief Regional Secretary, SBIOA(Bengal Circle), Administrative Zonal committee, Howrah and Com Prabir Sorkhel, Assistant Secretary, SBIOA (Bengal Circle) who presented a brief significance of the meeting. The anchors then proceeded to invite Circle President, Com Asitava Kundu and General Secretary, Com Shubhajyoti Chattopadhyay to the dais who received the leaders on the dais. Thereafter, Com G. Thereafter, Com President of the meeting invited the leaders on the dais to deliver their valuable speech to the house.

Com G. Subramanyam, Chairman AISBOF, General Secretary, SBIOA (Hyderabad Circle), in his address to the august house, expressed his appreciation to the senior leaders present in the house along with their better halves. He was

happy to mention that the new Circle President and General Secretary have already started their journey with the new Circle Transfer Policy. He praised Com Soumya Datta who had taken Bengal Circle to a great height. He highlighted the various anti people policies and the policies of the Government to dismantle the public sector. He expressed his concerns over various issues like shortage of manpower, low promotion from clerical cadre to JMGS-I, CDS, Corporate NPAs, Risk of Advance etc. He appreciated the initiatives of the previous leadership in combating the threat of the Government to the PSBs. Appraising the introduction of "People's Parliament" by Com D. T. Franco, he opined that mass support needed to be gathered to fight against the Govt.'s anti people policy. He expressed his confidence that AIBOC and AISBOF would be led in the right direction under the leadership of Com Soumya Datta. He also appreciated the action and the initiatives of Com Ram Kumar Sabapathy during his short tenure as General Secretary of the mighty Federation.

Com Sambit Misra, president AISBOF, General Secretary, SBIOA (Bhubaneswar Circle) expressed his satisfaction over the activities of AIBOC by its previous leader Com Franco who made AIBOC, a symbol of fight for justice. He mentioned the movement against FRDI Bill, People's Parliament etc. He is confident that the new leadership will carry forward the struggle to a new height. He reminded the movement and strike for 17 days in 1969 just to get the right to have casual leave by the officers. He apprehended the immediate threats of merger of Banks and privatization of PSUs by the newly Government. He presented a strong argument against privatization citing the failure of Jet Airways and other private companies. He urged upon appointment of Officer Member into the Board of Directors of the Bank.

Com Sunil Shinde, Jt General Secretary, AISBOF, General Secretary SBIOA (Mumbai Circle) apprised the house about the challenges faced by the Associations in recent times. He mentioned the challenges to improve upon the pathetic service condition of the officers, stalemate position of wage revision, creation and development of new and young leaders for future days. To depict the pathetic working condition of the officers, he cited a living example that 60 % of the clerical staff were opting out to become JMGS-I or TO. He stressed on fighting and struggling, unity and solidarity and devotion and dedication towards associations to survive and sustain in future days.

In his address to the august house, Com D T F Rajendra Dev, former General Secretary, AIBOC and former president of AISBOF, felt proud of Bengal Circle, especially Com Soumya Datta who was leading from forefront with his dedication, intelligence and uncompromising fighting instinct to achieve the goal. He deliberated that leaders should always be vigilant, alert and smart to counter the unexpected threats and challenges coming either from the management or from the government, in any form. He ratified the actions and functioning of Com Soumya Dutta, present G.S of AIBOC, who had been fighting in the right direction, be it in the issue of wage revision, scrapping of NPS, against merger of PSBs, protesting against non-payment of salary to the employees of BSNL etc. He emphasized on the importance of maintaining PSUs in our Country. Citing the example of our success in withdrawing FRDI bill, he encouraged the members to fight and fight to get the ultimate success. He expressed his confidence that under the leadership of Com Soumya Dutta, the AIBOC & AISBOF would reach to a new height and the members would get their due justice. He praised for the wise decision of Com Datta for relinquishing the post of General Secretary of the Circle Association and handing over the mantle to the younger generation. He advised the young generation to read more and be educated to raise their voice and fight and also handed over a Book to Com Shubhajyoti Chattopadhyay, General Secretary, SBIOA (Bengal Circle).

Com Ramkumar Sabapathy, former General Secretary, AISBOF appreciated Com Soumya Datta for giving chance to the younger generation, for developing future leaders and handing over the baton of General Secretary of the Circle Association to ComShubhajyoti Chattopadhyay who remained very hard working and a dedicated comrade and soldier of the association. He highlighted some achievements of Federation during his tenure like 100% Medical Reimbursement for treatment of family members, reduction of premium on Health Insurance of retired employees, release of Transfer Order of 4500 officers on ICT etc. He praised all the comrades of Bengal Circle for providing him enormous support in functioning his business in effective manner. He advised all to give feedback in CDS pointing out the flaws in it honestly.
