Comrade Abhijit Chattopadhyay, a dedicated soldier of the Association had joined the Bank on 10th September, 1991 at Zonal Office, Burdwan as Cashier-cum-Clerk and was subsequently posted at Mejia Branch in February, 1992. He was Unit Secretary, SBISA (Bengal Circle) during his stay at Mejia (1994-97). After his transfer to Kadamtala Branch, Howrah Module, he got promoted to Officers' Cadre in 2004 and got posted at Zonal Office, Burdwan. He has befittingly shouldered many assignments in different tiers of the Circle Association. He was elected as Regional President, Region – I, Howrah in 2009. He was repatriated to Region – V, Howrah Module in 2015. He became AZC Member, Howrah Module in January, 2018. Considering his organising capabilities he was inducted in the Central Committee Member in 2022. The Central Committee unanimously assigned the responsibility of Asst. Secretary Finance, SBIOA (Bengal Circle) from February, 2025, a post he has held till the date of his retirement. As an officer, Comrade Chattopadhyay, has excelled in various assignments.
