Dear Comrade,

We bid adieu to our beloved comrade, Comrade Sourav Majumder, Central Committee Member of SBIOA (Bengal Circle). Having served the Association with unwavering dedication, sincerity, and devotion, he retires from the Bank's service as of the close of business today, 28th February 2026.

Comrade Sourav Majumder, a dedicated soldier of the Association, joined the Bank on 31st December 1987 at New Bongaigaon Industrial Estate Branch in the N.E. Circle as a Cashier-cum-Clerk. He was promoted to the officer cadre in 2005. Prior to his promotion, he was closely associated with SBISA and served as an SBISA Delegate.

From 1992 to 1996, he worked in the Inspection & Audit Department. Post-promotion, he was posted as Cash Officer at Canning Branch, a Currency Chest branch. He showed his mettle as an officer there. Consequent to his induction into the supervisory cadre, Comrade Majumder became actively involved with SBIOA (Bengal Circle).

After repatriation to the Siliguri Module in 2007, he served as a Field Officer at Station Feeder Road Branch. He shouldered key responsibilities across tiers of the Circle Association, including as Unit Secretary of the Station Feeder Road Composite Unit and Administrative Zonal Committee (AZC) Member, Siliguri Module in 2010.

Promoted to MMGS-II in 2010, he was transferred to Tarapith Branch, Burdwan Module in 2014. Upon repatriation to Siliguri Module, he was elected as AZC Member in 2015, became Vice-President of AZC, Siliguri Module in 2023, and was co-opted as Central Committee Member in 2024 - a role he held until retirement. As an officer of the Bank, Comrade Majumder excelled in diverse assignments, and at the same time earning acclaim for his trustworthiness in championing members' causes in his organisational capacity.

A soft-spoken individual with an amiable nature, he was extremely devoted to the cause of the Association. His passion for cultural and social activities is well known.
